A Family for Every Child is dedicated to finding loving, permanent families for every waiting foster child.

A Family For Every Child, a nonprofit organization, was started by Christy Obie-Barrett and dozens of dedicated and passionate volunteers. In 2006, AFFEC was formed and developed into an organization focused on finding permanent and loving adoptive homes for all waiting children. Our intention is to develop programs that assist specialneeds/challenging-to-place foster children in finding their own Forever Families.

We started with our first sole project called The Heart Gallery in November, 2006, and now we have blossomed into ten incredibly successful programs. # **Volunteer/Intern Positions**

### **Private Investigator:**

In our Family Finding Program, we look for relatives of foster children. The Family Finding model is a group of methods and strategies to locate and engage relatives of children living in out-of-home care. The goal of Family Finding is to provide each child with the lifelong connections that only a family can offer.

We are looking for someone with good research skills, can follow deadlines, and have access to databases to do people searches to assist with our Family Finding Program. This is someone who must have PI experience. We need a volunteer who can commit to at least 5-10 hours a week.

### Family Finding Follow-Up Coordinator:

Family Finding is a program that finds relatives and other lost loved ones for children in foster care. We are looking for a follow-up coordinator for our Family Finding jobs. This volunteer must be able to work 10+ hours a week in or out of the A Family For Every Child office building. The volunteer must complete a Family Finding training as well as a Follow-up training

### **Mentor Recruitor:**

Our mentor program is one of the very important programs in our organization. Foster children are matched with adult mentors, who encourage and support them through various transitions in their life. We are looking for someone who will do extensive recruitment to fulfill our mentor needs. This person needs to identify how and where we find committed mentors who will provide consistency and permanency to our youth in care.

This volunteer needs to be engaging and be able to speak to the program needs. We need a volunteer who can commit to at least 10 hours a week.

### **Mentor Program Intern:**

We are looking for an intern to assist the program director in expanding the Mentor Program. This person needs to be passionate about the mission of finding enthusiastic, dedicated, caring adult members from our community and uniting them with youth in foster care.

This volunteer needs to be organized and be able to do data entry and follow-up. We need a volunteer who can commit to at least 10-20 hours a week.

### **Sponsorship Event Coordinator:**

This person would be in charge of organizing various events in the local community, setting up sponsorship booths and tables and representing the agency as well as the Sponsorship Program. We need a volunteer who can commit to at least 7-10 hours a week.

### **Sponsorship Marketing Coordinator:**

Our Sponsorship Program is a program that gives opportunities for people and businesses to sponsor a child, a sibling group, different programs, mentors and even a family trying to adopt. We are looking for a volunteer that can help write the newsletters for our Sponsorship Program and work on recruitment and marketing of this program.

We need a volunteer who can commit to at least 7+ hours a week.

### Child Recruitment Intern:

We are looking for an intern to research other agencies recruitment efforts and how we can improve our own recruitment program. This person will do outreach to case workers, take diligent notes and analysis of the program while being very professional. This intern will also be in charge of creating a child recruitment webpage.
