Database /Administrative Support

These positions assist with communicating with social workers, working within our complex database, creating newsletters, working to form partnerships with states and workers to help with recruitment efforts of children, information research projects and more! This is great work experience for those seeking to learn new skills or improve upon skills they already have. It is also a wonderful opportunity for students over the age of 18.

Child Recruitment Assistant:

These positions are responsible for locating children that are available for adoption and communicating with case workers to provide various services to locate potential adoptive families. This position requires solid computer skills as well as good written and verbal communication skills.

Family Finding Volunteers

Family Finding volunteers help to locate lost connections, biological or otherwise, for children currently in the foster care system.

Mentors

Our Mentor program is a great way to make a difference in a child's life! We are especially interested in male mentors. A one year commitment of ten hours per week and background check is required for this position.
